The Greek authorities are planning to move asylum seekers to a Closed Control Access Centre (CCAC) in Lesvos, Greece. A camp surrounded by barbed-wire fences and concrete walls, and with 24/7 surveillance, 36 km away from the city. These measures regulate the residents—their freedom of movement—so they are de facto in a state of detention, isolated from the world, waiting for their asylum procedure. Children will be kept there.
